## Summer Safety

As the temperature outside increases, so does our exposure to the sun and the water. We know how precious your children are to you so wanted to share a few safety reminders provided by the American Red Cross.

\*Swim in designated areas supervised by lifequards.

\*Always swim with a buddy. Do not allow anyone to swim alone.

\*Ensure that everyone in the family learns to swim well. Enroll in ageappropriate Red Cross water orientation and Learn-to-Swim courses. Never leave a young child unattended near water.

\*Have young children or inexperienced swimmers wear U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jackets around water,.

\*Establish rules for your family and enforce them without fail. For example, set limits based on each person's ability, do not let anyone play around drains and suction fittings, and do not allow swimmers to hyperventilate before swimming under water or have breath-holding contests.

\*Remember to stay hydrated. The sun can cause you to become dehydrated.


## Wear RED on Wednesday
