**Gifted Screening Available**

Parents may request that their child be screened for the gifted program by October 31st. All second grade students will be screened, unless their parent opts out of this screening. The identification and establishing eligibility for the gifted program is a yearlong process. After the screening, if a child scores high enough, he/she will be referred to our school psychologist and will be given an individual IQ test.
