

## <u>IMPORTANT!</u> HAC / Registration for next year

Parents,

In an effort to keep records confidential and secure, we are asking one parent or Legal Guardian for each child to come by school to pick up their Home Access Center (HAC) account information and instructions. With this information, you will be able to log in to your child's school account to update emergency contacts, phone numbers, etc... as well as review grades. Once the account is established, it will remain with your child from school year to school year, thus allowing you to keep your child's records up to date and accurate. Several students already have an account set up. If you are already using HAC, we ask that you please update your child's records by Wednesday, May 27, 2015 (Instructions are available at the front office). If you do not have a HAC account and need one set up, please bring your photo ID to the front office one day next week. You will be given instructions on how to set up your child's account and how to log in. If you do not have a log in, one will be created for you. All students need their accounts updated before the end of this school year - this will count as your child's registration form for the next school year. Thank you!

\*\*Remember, if your child is attending KES on an "Out of Zone Waiver" you must reapply for a Zone Waiver every school year. If you have moved out of the KES zone, you must also apply for a waiver to remain at KES. You can apply at:


## **Attention - 5th GRADERS!**
