While doing this, you will need to make sure your current phone number is on file. If incorrect, please make the changes so that any Alert Now messaging (phone or email) will be sent to you. It updates nightly from the Home Access Center. Also, to find out about your child's teacher for next year, you must have registered/updated your HAC!

So, speaking of next year...

Did you know that school starts on **August 10th?** Yes, that is much earlier than years past, but the last day of school will be May 26th! I like the idea that we are done before Memorial Day. We have communicated this for about six months and will not accept any requests for excused absences during the beginning of the 15-16 school year. It is important that all parents have a school calendar available in order to plan family vacations and appointments. We found it difficult for students, and parents too, to make up missed instruction. You cannot make up what a teacher has taught in class, as well as and the interaction and collaboration with other students.
