**WELCOME AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Mrs. Prodromides opened the meeting and requested a review of the May, 2009 minutes. Mrs. Gauronskas made the motion to approve the minutes as read. Mrs. Redmon seconded the motion. Mr. Jenkins clarified that Ketterlinus Elementary School made the most learning gains in the state of Florida. Motion passed.

**BUDGET:**

2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Think Link testing

Too many problems with F.A.I.R. – dropped for grades 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>.

We only have \$3,000. Motion to approve 15 substitutes made by Carole Gauronskas; seconded by Angela Redmon. Motion passed.

School grade data: Florida Writes this year - Wayne Jenkins explained there will be no multiple choice section. There will be one prompt and one grader to score Writes test. Score of (3) – considered passing.

School Recognition Money: Team will be combination of SAC and faculty/staff. Will decide what happens to the \$ - how it is disbursed. Staff representatives will come up with a plan and it will go to entire staff/faculty for vote. SAC must approve it. This process must be completed by November 1<sup>st</sup> or all the money automatically goes to faculty. SAC will receive e-mail to vote by Oct. 26<sup>th</sup>. Motion to approve this process was made by Jeanette Booth and seconded by Carole Gauronskas. Motion approved.
