Approval of April Minutes

Keri Prodromedes read the copy of April Minutes.... See copy.
Minutes were approved by Angela Redmon, 2nd by Ellen Davern, all approved.

Budget- Wayne Jenkins asked Darrell Colee to clarify information about the budget.

W. Jenkins said that there was not much money left in the budget, one of the SAC chairs to be paid by budget (District pays for one – Darrell Colee clarifies) while the SAC pays for the other out of budget and rent (\$529.00).

Darrell Colee stated that lottery money will be given to the district for SAC (FTE) money added to it and carried over to next year (amount unknown at this time).

The District budget will have a 1.5 percent reduction this year.

Both Wayne Jenkins and Kathy Tucker discussed that the budget will be very conservative for next year.

The projected student count is 477 (493) enrollment FTE.

The Title I budget is still being worked on for next year, as well as what is left of this year's monies.

Hope to have around \$200 for classroom supplies as well as a grade level wish list.

Received \$72, 000 last year as stimulus dollars, which will be in place for one more year-not sure about the amount after that. Title I funds were used for tutoring, positions, FCAT Blast

St. Johns County is listed as the 36th in the state in funding provided per student.

Old Business

There was no old business discussed.

New Business

Wayne Jenkins – ‘Salute to America’ next week, Wednesday, May 24th

K-2 and 3-5 programs will be more multimedia with fewer speakers and less talk.

Dana Ste Claire – will speak on the 2012 Ponce de Leon’s Birthday and St. Augustine’s 450th celebration.

This should provide opportunities to Integrate social studies and have KES lead the way, speakers, field trip, etc.

Lt. Col Booth will also be a speaker at the program.

Kris Hutson is working on the presentation to combine music (Bob Neal) with a multimedia slide show.

Need parents attending the ‘Salute to America’ program to ‘Sign in’ on Title I form (remind Wayne Jenkins).

2009-2010 – School – Parent Involvement Policy/Plan (Title I) – DRAFT was handed out to review.

2010-2011 – Policy to be addressed (outline) to match the Plan from last year to correlate the formats

Carole Gauronskas-- Parent Involvement coordinator (spend 1% to 2%)

Add new ideas with parent input to included and improve the involvement of parents.

This summer, Kathy Tucker, along with SAC chairs and others of her choice, will get together to start finalizing the plan.

Kathy Tucker – Wants the SIP (School Improvement Plan) to be used as a ‘road map’.

Title I Schools – giving \$100 a day to meet (2 days)? classroom? during summer.

FOCUS calendars (continuous.....) workshop available this summer.

SNAP Shot – program to look at the data to be able to use it to help develop components of the SIP.

Good News – District student services will have a health tech or nurse to ‘man’ the clinic for each school site.

They are hiring nurses for RN or LPN to serve in the schools (shift work).

Karen has really stepped up by helping out with our medical services here at KES.

Darrell Colee has truly provided a wealth of information as our ‘District Buddy’ and will return and continue next year.

Kathy Tucker shared at the grade chair meeting (Wed., May 19th) that there will be some room changes in 2nd grade with the possibility of having Associate Teachers; as needed due to the class size amendments. Unique opportunity to change rooms will also be discussed and the use of Assistant Teachers. Each grade level has had teachers step up to have gifted endorsements (8 teachers involved).

A Gifted blended model is what we will be working towards – blended vs. resource.

Gifted students grouped together then blended.

Schedules (ESE will be looked at first) to be reviewed and refresh to meet the needs of students and their IEP and EP’s.

Resource schedule to be ‘tweaked’ to help facilitate and serve the ESE/Gifted students. (It won’t change too much, hopefully.)

Lead Teachers (Associate Teachers mentors) - decide at the beginning of school to have it already in place as to who will be the teacher to be assigned the associate teacher.

Being ‘landlocked’ and having a ‘high mobility’ student body create unique needs at KES
