Dear KES Family & Friends -

Thank you for a wonderful and successful school year. By far, this has been one of the best student bodies. They are great examples of what a child should be – raised with great character. Overall, they are the kindest and most caring group of students. I will truly miss our fifth grade students as they have been wonderful leaders to our younger students.

As we plan for next school year, I will need your assistance. We are adding more students to our school from an area previously zoned for Palencia. Our school district is continuing to experience growth in all schools. Our school will be very limited on space. As a result, early enrollment is necessary. If you see any neighbors or friends that have new students to the school district, please encourage them to **enroll NOW**. This will allow us to hire the required staff early and prevent class changes. I cannot stress this enough. Early registration for new students is very important.

As mentioned, classroom space will be limited. I have asked teachers to cut back on the typical supplies they request at the beginning of the year. Although the supplies are needed during the year, we cannot provide storage for them. Instead, I encourage the donation of \$5.00 gift cards so that teachers can buy the supplies as they run out versus storing them in the classroom. Please check individual supply lists for details and optional donation of gift cards. With increased enrollment, we will need the space in the classroom for small groups or one on one instruction. This will allow support staff to "push in" the classroom or planning room to assist students instead out of pulling them out of the class. We are utilizing every space within our school for classrooms next school year.

Over the summer, we will be upgrading several parts of the school – from school security cameras and monitors, landscaping, fencing, playground and front entrance area. In addition to those upgrades, we will be adding more technology at our school. A HUGE THANK YOU to our PTO for raising enough funds to purchase (80) laptops and other technology supplies. This will have a huge impact! We will also be purchasing mobile carts, interactive panels, and web-based software.

As we begin the planning for next school year, I encourage your child to READ! READ! READ! and to write in a journal daily. Also, please review the 17-18 Master Calendar to plan your vacations. School begins on August 10th!
