### **News from the Cove**

The 2017/2018 school year will be here before we know it! It is not too late to make plans for your child's morning/after-school care. We are already planning new and exciting things for the upcoming school year!

As the school year is winding down, we wanted to reach out to let everyone know about some incentives the Cove will be offering for this upcoming school year. Registration fees, paid on or before June 30th, are \$25. After June 30th, the fee will increase to \$50. These fees will be waived for students if the 1st Cove payment is made by May 24th.

As a reminder, Cove services are paid one month in advance beginning July 15th. School consists of 180 days. To make a convenient payment schedule we divide the full amount of those 180 days into 10 payments (20 bi-monthly payments).
