In this New Year, 2017, let's commit to reading with our kids every day. There is a wealth of research that supports the amount of time a child reads leads to academic success in reading! It



just makes sense! We learn to ride a bike, by spending more time riding. We learn to play a musical instrument by practicing outside of the lesson. We learn to become an athlete by practicing outside of team practice, and the same holds true for reading!

Why Can't I Skip My 20 Minutes of Reading Tonight?

Student "A" reads 20 minutes each day

3600 minutes in a school year

Student "B" reads 5 minutes each day

a school year

Student "C" reads 1 minute each day

900 minutes in 180 minutes in a school year

50th percentile

8,000 words

One Tetanus-diphtheria-acellular pertussis (Tdap)

Two doses of Varicella
