#### Check-out Policy

If you need to check your student out early, please know that we do not permit early checkout after 2:15pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday and after 1:15pm on Wednesday. We are preparing to dismiss our students, and teachers are finishing academic instruction for the day. Thank you for understanding!

Housekeeping

Dismissal Changes

Parents/guardians, please be sure to note student's dismissal changes in your student's planner. This helps us to ensure a safe dismissal and avoid classroom interruption. In the event of an emergency dismissal change, please call before 1:15pm (Wed)/2:15pm (M, Tu, Th & Fr).

#### Car Tags

Car tags must be displayed on your rearview mirror when picking up your child in Parent Pick-Up. This helps the staff to identify you as someone who is allowed to pick up your student and gives staff the opportunity to radio ahead so that your child is ready at the curb for pick-up. Additional car tags may be purchased at the front office for \$2 (cash only). In addition, please make sure you display your car tag when parked in our school parking lot to avoid being towed.

#### School Access

To enter any St. John County school, you MUST have an approved School Access Form on file and scan your Driver's License at the front office. The application link is located on our KES website under School Access. This process can take up to 4-6 weeks. School Access lasts for 3 years, and it is the responsibility of the applicant to contact Volunteer Services at 904-547-3952 or Donna Ott at <u>donna.ott@stjohns.k12</u>. <u>fl.us</u> to renew the form. Please do not reapply, as this creates duplicate forms.

#### Safety Reminders

- Drop off begins at 7:55am Safety is our top priority at KES. Please do not allow your child to wait on the school property unsupervised.
- Please use the crosswalk when walking your child to school.
- All school zones and crossings are Hands Free Zones. Please finish your phone calls or texts before entering the parking lot and crossing zone if you do not have hands-free capabilities.

#### Home Access Center (HAC)

Please be sure to utilize this for reviewing your child's report cards and monitoring their progress throughout the year.

#### **Tardiness**

School opens at 7:55am. Students are tardy if not in their classroom by 8:25am. If a student arrives after 8:25am their parent/guardian must walk up to the front office to sign them in.

<u>Please label all your child's belongings</u> such as water bottles, lunchboxes, backpacks, etc. This helps us to return items to your child when they are misplaced.

## Family Portal Score Reporting Updates

### FAST Grades 3-10 Assessments:

Student scores for FAST PM2 are currently available in the Family Portal. Families are able to see and print their student's scale score, achievement level, and a bar graph indicating the student's scale score and where it falls in the achievement level.

Note: PM2 Individual Student Reports (ISRs) will be loaded to the Family Portal in mid-January for the students who tested in December. All remaining PM2 ISRs will be available in the Family Portal by the end of February. These ISRs will include percentile ranks and will include the students who tested in January.

Access codes for students in grade 3-10 are available in HAC under the Registration tab.
