The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a progress monitoring system that is administered three times per year to track your student's progress in learning the Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards throughout this school year. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that your student will take the Renaissance Star Early Literacy, Star Reading, and/or Star Math assessment(s) on:

- **May 12th** - Kindergarten Early Literacy
- **May 13th** - 1st Grade Reading
- **May 15th** - 2nd Grade Reading
- **May 16th** - Kindergarten Math
- **May 19th** - 1st Grade Math
- **May 20th** - 2nd Grade Math

The results from PM3 will show how well your student has mastered the grade level content standards, and your school will provide information about how to access the results.

Your student's FAST assessments are computer-adaptive tests taken on a computer or tablet. The questions get less or more difficult depending on how a student responds, and each student will see different questions.
