In addition, our Youth Resource Deputies facilitate several in school programs, to include Safety Programs, Mentoring, Anti-Bullying Initiatives, Drug Prevention, and Intervention Programs. Our deputies provide guidance for the safe use of the internet and computers. Technology is a great tool to assist in education but it can also bring its own challenges for parents and children. It is incredibly important for parents to remain vigilant and aware of what their children's activities online and otherwise are. Together, we can restrict those who attempt to exploit our children.
