PROGRAMS OF STUDY

BAND

BAND PROVIDES STUDENTS AN OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN AN INSTRUMENT. MUSIC THEORY AND AURAL LISTENING SKILLS ARE WOVEN INTO ALL LESSONS TO AID IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF MUSICIANSHIP. MUSIC IS SELECTED TO CHALLENGE STUDENT'S SKILL LEVELS AND EXPOSE THEM TO A VAST ARRAY OF MUSICAL GENRES.

CHORUS

THE CHOIR PROGRAM PUTS STUDENTS THROUGH A RIGOROUS COURSE TO DEVELOP VOCAL TECHNIQUE AND MUSICIANSHIP SKILLS. STUDENTS LEARN TO SING IN TWO & THREE-PART HARMONIES AND HOW TO SIGHT-READ MELODIC AND RHYTHMIC MUSIC USING SOLFEGE. STUDENTS HAVE AMPLE OPPORTUNITIES TO PERFORM MUSIC FROM A VARIETY OF GENRES AND LANGUAGES THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOLYEAR.

DANCE

THE DANCE PROGRAM EXPOSES STUDENTS OF ALL LEVELS TO MANY STYLES OF DANCE BY WAYS OF TECHNIQUE, TERMINOLOGY, HISTORY, AND CHOREOGRAPHY. STUDENTS HAVE SEVERAL PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

GRAPHIC DESIGN

THE DIGITAL/GRAPHIC DESIGN PROGRAM OFFERS STUDENTS IN DEPTH TRAINING ON ADOBE PROGRAMS TO DEVELOP NECESSARY GRAPHIC DESIGN SKILLS NEEDED TO ENTER ADVANCE COURSEWORK AND DEVELOP A STRONG PORTFOLIO IN THE FUTURE.

THEATRE

THE THEATRE ARTS PROGRAM HAS A STRONG EMPHASIS ON PERFORMANCE AND SKILL BUILDING FOR STUDENTS AT ALL LEVELS. OUR CURRICULUM EXPLORES STUDIES IN NOT ONLY PERFORMANCE AND CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT, BUT ALSO THEATRE HISTORY, DESIGN, AND TECHNICAL THEATRE.
