Read and write numerals up to 20.
Recognize all 26 uppercase, lowercase, and produce the 26 letter sounds.
Be able to decode basic CVC (consonant vowel consonant) words.
example: dog, cat, bed, tub, and sit.
Produce rhyming words.
Recognize beginning, middle, and ending sounds of words.
Recognize and read the District Kindergarten Sight Words *see back
Write a simple sentence using invented spelling using a capital letter at the beginning a period at the end.
Students should know and be able to spell their first and last name.
Tie shoes without assistance.
Respond respectfully and politely when conversing with adults and peers.
Be ORGANIZED and neat with backpack, folders, and desk.
Listen to and follow directions and instructions.
Use the bathroom independently, including hand washing.
Know when and how to blow their nose and remember to wash their hands.
