

Fifth Grade Readiness Checklist

The expectations below will give your child a strong foundation for all the learning that will take place in 5th grade:

- Respond respectfully and with scholarly language when spoken to by adults and peers.
- Be ORGANIZED and neat with your materials and work space.
- Set and meet deadlines.
- Critically problem solve before seeking help from an adult.
- Accept ownership of your actions.
- Work independently and collaboratively - share roles and listen to peers' opinions.
- Know all of your multiplication facts through 12, fluently.
- Know place values to at least 100,000 (one hundred thousand).
- Know basic attributes of 2D figures.
- Write for extended periods of time, using correct capitalization and punctuation.
- Be prepared to practice STAR daily – Setting up notes, taking notes, adding to notes, and reviewing notes.
- Read daily for at least 30 minutes - more is even better! Build your reading stamina.
- Maintain a growth mindset throughout the year and persevere with grit!
